

Conditions of Sale for Commission Bidders

1. The Auctioneers will undertake to secure lots at the lowest possible amount.
2. Purchasers Shotguns, Firearms, Airguns, Ammunition and heavy items will be required to arrange for collection by their own carrier from the Auction office. In this case an additional charge for package will be made. Welsh Arms are not able to arrange for an appropriate carrier.
3. The Auctioneers will not be responsible for wrong lot numbers entered by commission bids against correct descriptions although checks will be made by auction staff where possible.
4. Successful bidders will be informed by post, fax or e-mail and an invoice with details of purchases enclosed . Carriage and package charges will be billed separately if required. Please inform the auction office if you would like your items posted or if you can arrange to collect them when you make your commission bids. Items will be stored without charge for up to four weeks after the date of the sale.
5. Payment will be required in full within ten days. Accounts not cleared within ten days will incur an interest charge.
6. We cannot always guarantee to let you know if your bids were unsuccessful though details of prices realized will be available from the auction office.
7. Telephone bids can be arranged for any lot with an estimated value of over £100.
8. If you find that you can attend the auction in person we can cancel your commission bids on the day of the sale.
9. Commission bid can only be accepted before 10.00 hrs on the morning of the Auction.
10. By making a commission bid this will confirm that you have understood and will comply with the above conditions.
